It has been several months since we wrote last so we'll just send you a little month by month replay of what's been happening here in **Zambia** at the **Kafakumba Training Center** and the Rivendell Farm where we live.

July: Last newsletter went out – right after Pastors' School and the women's empowerment seminar had finished. Several visitors came from the States. (During this year we will have hosted about 60 visitors from overseas!)

August: Family Camp Meeting time. Several hundred people came from the nearby districts for a long weekend of preaching, Bible studies, classes about health, development, and parenting as well as camp fires and fellowship. Visitors from Arkansas and Chicago were able to participate in the Family Camp. Very busy time in the cattle pen with lots of calves being born.

September: Elections were held here in Zambia with the opposition candidate being voted in during a relatively peaceful poll. Visitors from Texas came to brainstorm with us concerning further construction and remodeling plans for the center. Bumper crop of bananas this month, as well as new baby banana plants arriving from South Africa.

October: Friends of ours from Vancouver and Arizona arrived with molds, wicks, etc. We provided the beeswax, and our friends taught some of the local women how to make candles and lip balm with the beeswax. Very exciting time for the women!

November: Trip to the States, speaking, visiting with family and friends, traveling around the US. Launched the Kafakumba Pastors' School Endowment Fund. (More information will follow as this program gets more established.) Second honey harvest for the year began towards the end of the month.

December: Back to Zambia where the rainy season has really started and everything has greened up! This month one of the groups using the training center was the Seventh Day Adventist youth conference. Kafakumba Training Center is used every month by a wide variety of church groups and other organizations at no cost. We welcome the chance to partner with other groups as they also seek to share God's love.

Each month is filled with activities and people that challenge us. These challenges make us more aware of how faithful God is and how much He loves us – so much that He sent Jesus to bring us the gift of abundant life. At this Christmas season and in the coming year may you experience God's gift of abundant life!
